# Curriculum for the Postgraduate University Course

### **ADVANCED STUDIES – MUSIC THEORY**

(Post-Master's Programme)

at the University of Music and Performing Arts Graz

#### Preamble

The Austrian University Act (2002) and the statutes of the University of Music and Performing Arts Graz form the legal basis of the postgraduate university course. The curriculum decided by the Curricular Committee on 24 May 2018 and approved by the Senate on 19 June 2018 came into force on 1 October 2018.

#### **Qualifications** profile

The purpose of the course is to enhance individual artistic and/or artistic-academic skills intensively to the highest possible level. The course is supplemented by numerous practical opportunities (concerts, PPCM, intermedia projects, symposia, conferences, etc.).

## **Admission requirements**

A completed diploma or master's (or equivalent degree) programme in the relevant major artistic subject at a postsecondary educational institution in Austria or abroad.

#### Admission

Applicants must submit a diploma or master's degree certificate (including certified translation for certificates in a language other than German or English). The examination board will make a decision regarding admission. This board of examination is identical to the board of admission examinations for the degree programme.

#### Admission examination

For the admission examination, three independent music theory works must be submitted and presented to the examination board.

#### **Duration**

The duration of this course is two semesters.

Students may repeat the course once (including the electives) with the prior agreement of the head of the major artistic subject, and with the approval of the Vice Rector for Academic Affairs.
